

God's plan for Noah was to build a big boat called an Ark.


When it was ready God would send a great flood upon the earth.





At last the rain had stopped. The Ark came to rest on a high mountain.


One day, Noah sent a raven from the Ark to see if the water had gone down. But the raven kept flying back and forth. Later, Noah sent out a dove which returned with nothing.








When the ground was dry again, God said to Noah, "Go out of the Ark and bring all the animals with you."


STORY 4: God's promise

Noah was thankful to God for keeping him and his family safe. He made an altar (special pile of stones) to say thank you.






