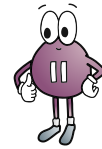

This story is about the coming of the Holy Spirit.

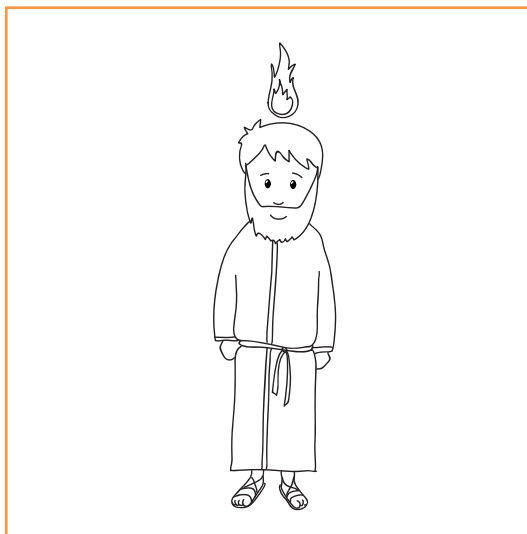


READ:

Colour the pictures.

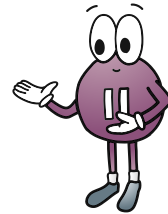

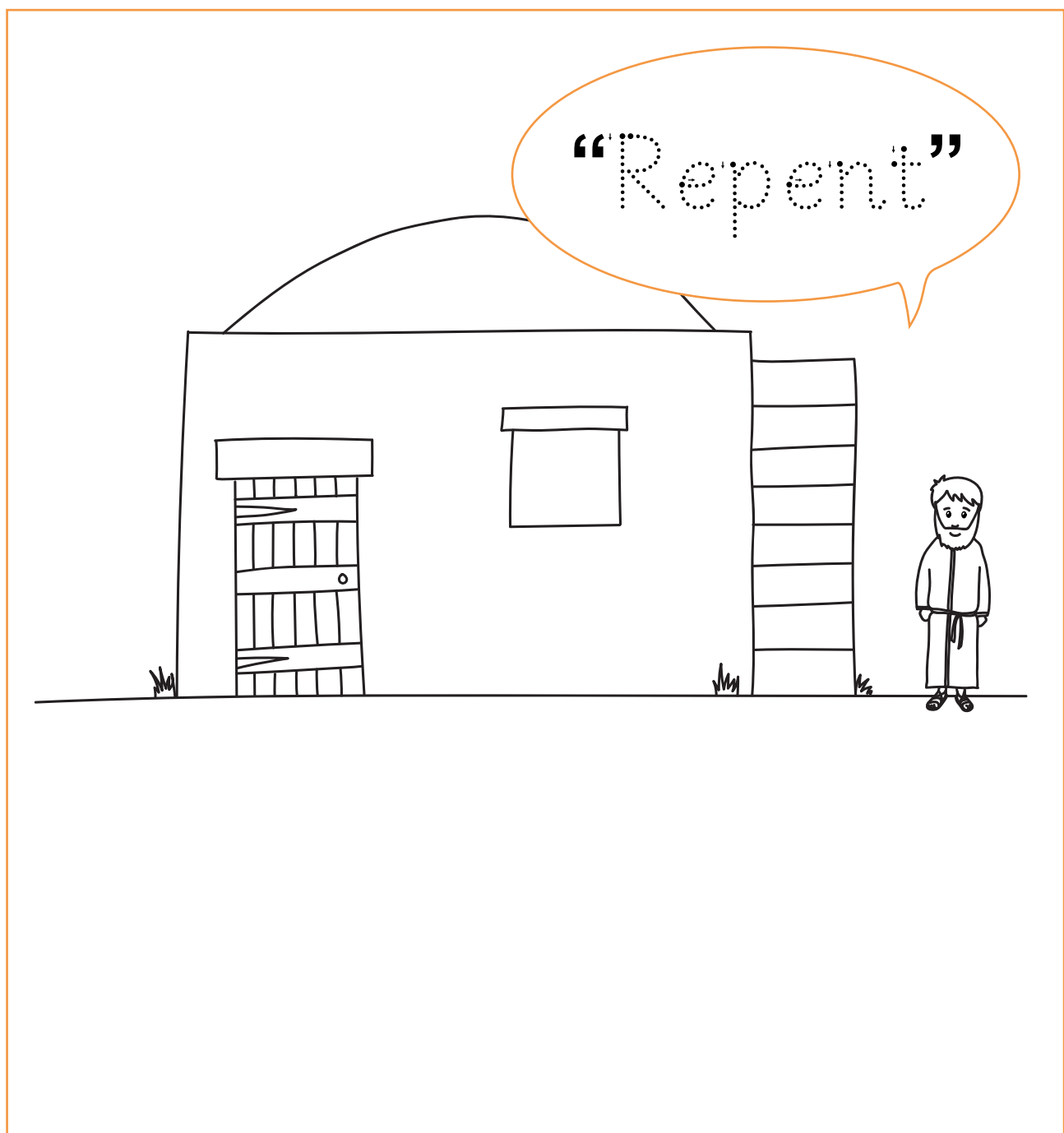

This story is about God's healing power.



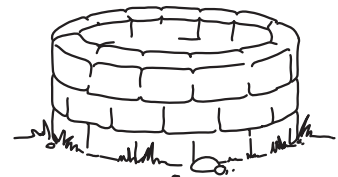
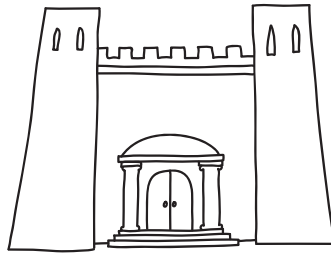
READ:

One day, not long after the Holy Spirit came, Peter and John were going into the Temple.

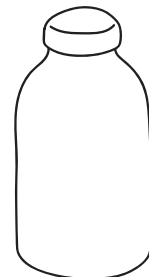
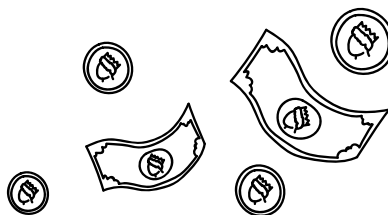
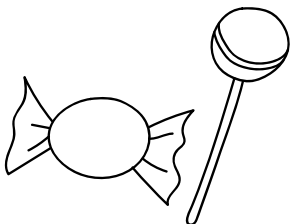

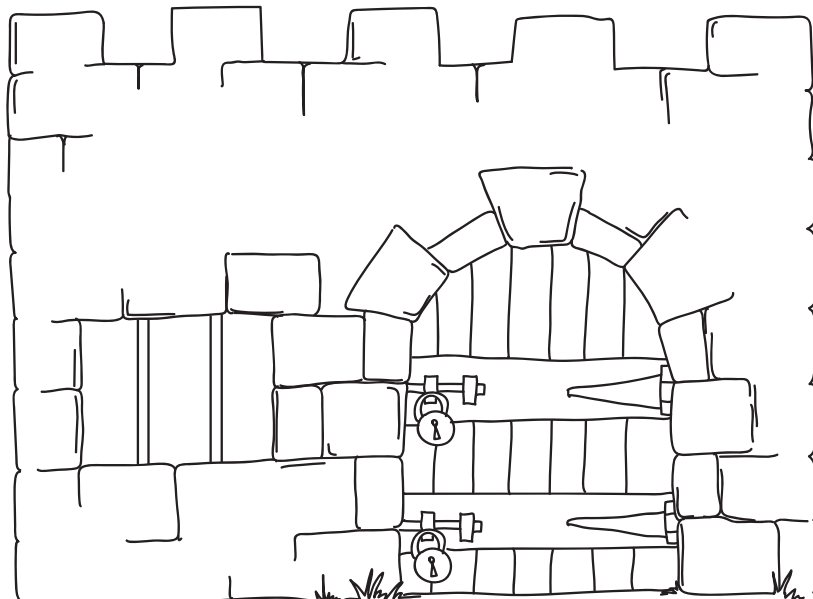
