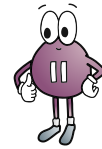

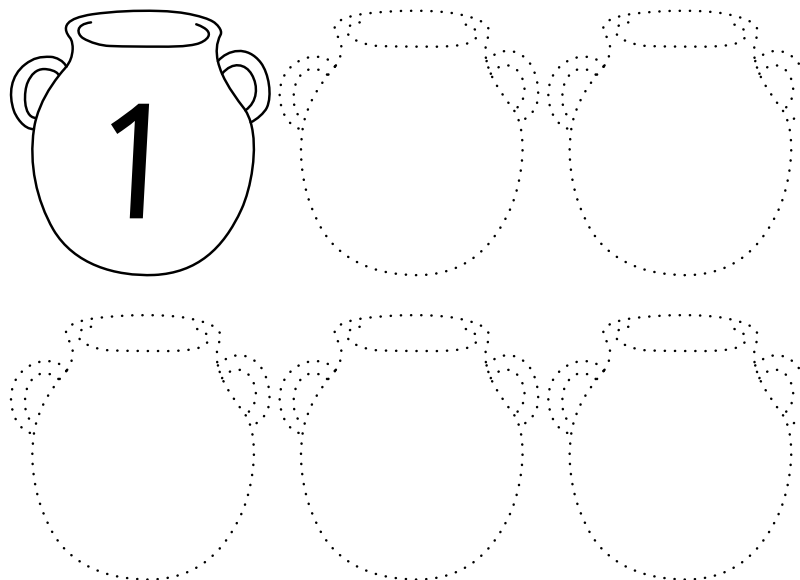

STORY 2: Jesus heals a sick boy

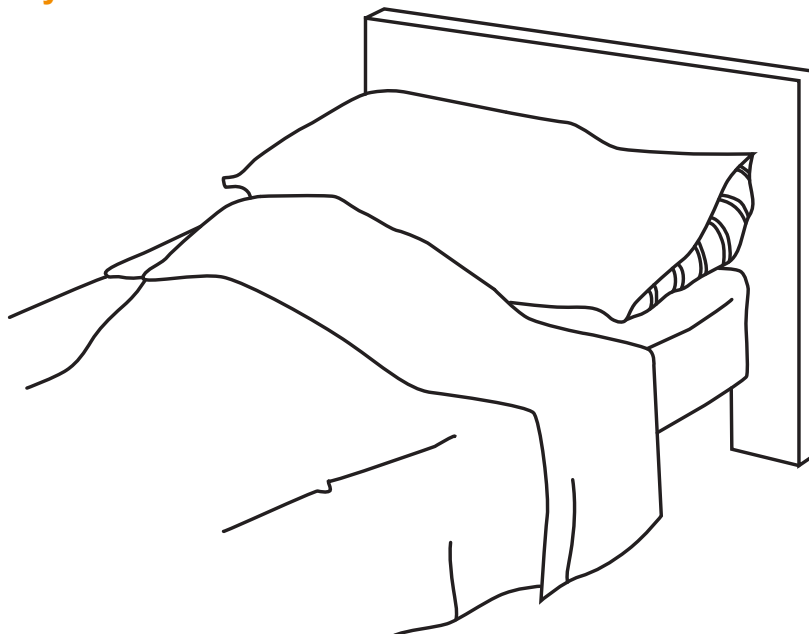
This story is about the power of Jesus.

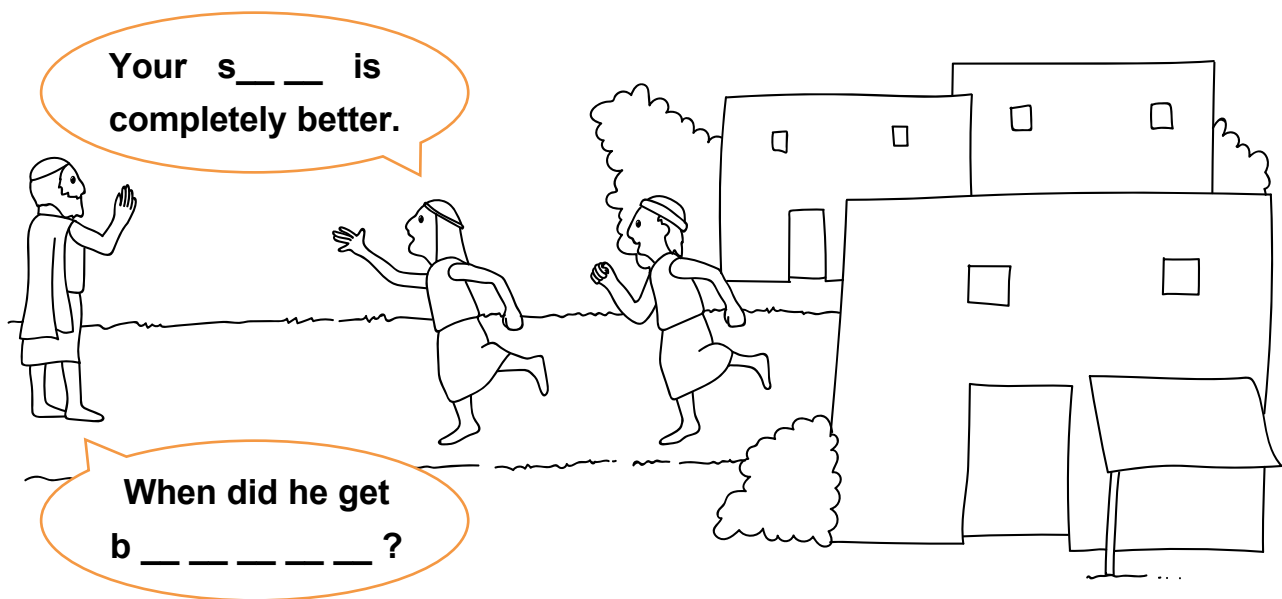

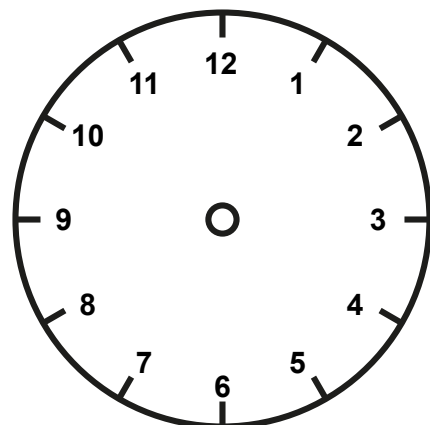

This story is about the healing of a blind man.

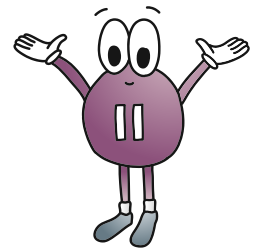


READ:

This story is about saying "Thank You" to Jesus.

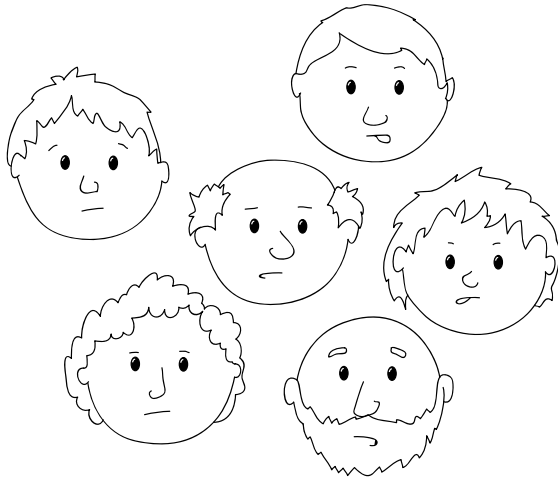


READ:

Draw 4 more men and complete the speech bubble.

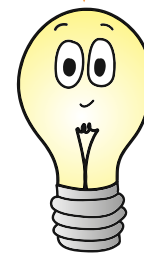

By saying "Thank You" to Jesus, the Samaritan man showed how much he appreciated his healing.



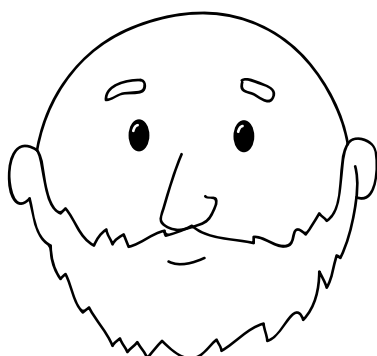
Colour the number of men who were healed RED.
