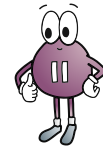

*God's care*



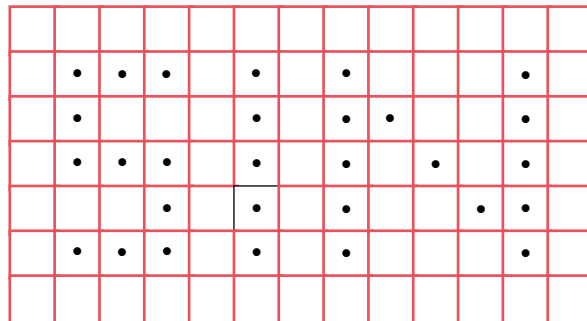
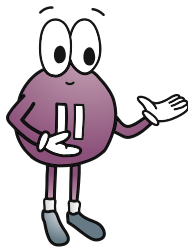
**READ:**

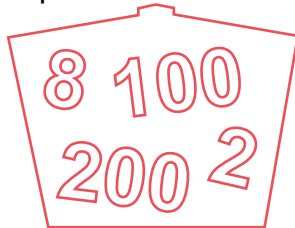

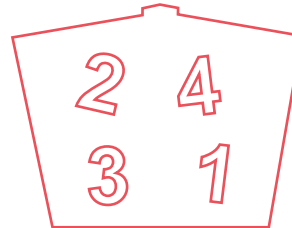
Noah did everything, just as God had told him. The Ark was made of gopher wood and had one door.

**Q:** Draw a circle around the first animal that Noah sent out from the Ark.



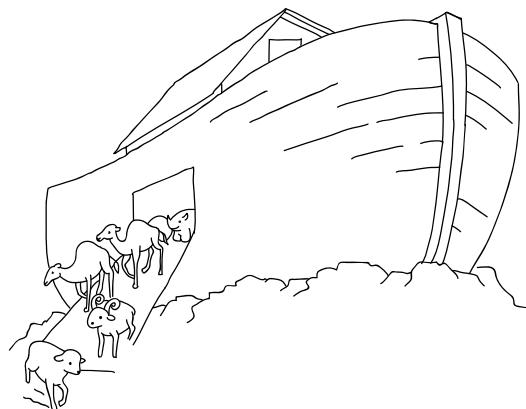

Then God showed them something which was to be a reminder of His promise. It was a rainbow. Every time Noah and his family saw a rainbow it reminded them of God's promise.

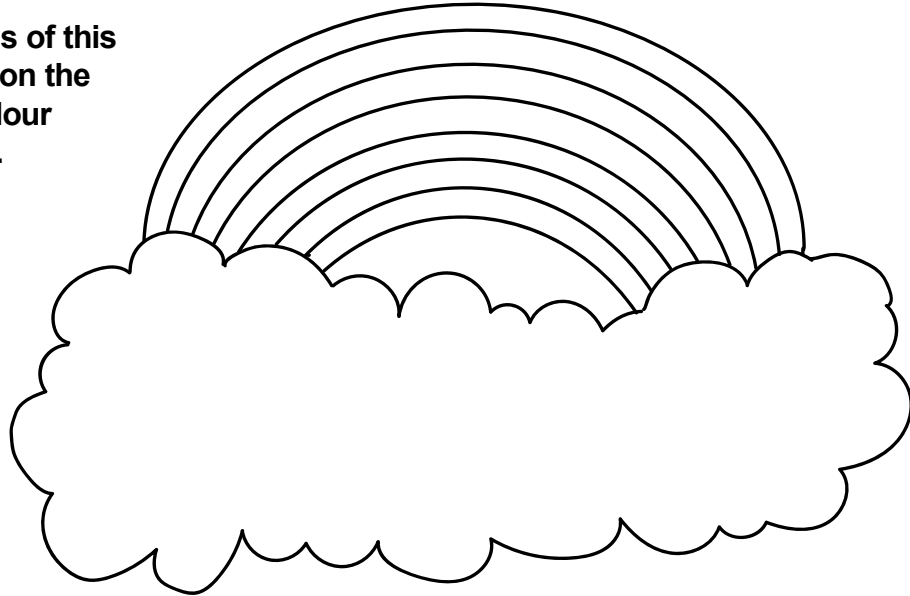
We can read God's promises in the Bible. One of God's greatest promises is that He will never leave those who trust in Him and follow Him.

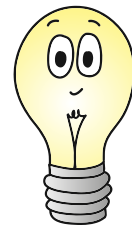
